Meeting was called to order at 7:05 p.m. by Mike Bradfield.

Coaches Remarks: The new stadium is coming along well and they hope to have it completed prior to the annual Blue/Gold game.

Presidents Comments: Mike discussed the set up of the new stadium. The coaches stated the old equipment garage will be the new ticket booth with concrete entry on both sides. There will be no entry on visitor's side of stadium. Practice gear will be kept in front of garage.

Treasurer Report: Sally reported start up amounts. No disbursements.

Membership: Membership benefits will remain the same (one free meal and 20% off Booster merchandise. Membership fee: Family \$35.00, Individual \$20.00, Student \$10.00.

Concessions: Varsity games concession proceeds will remain that of the OTHS Band Boosters. They have offered concessions on visitor's side to the OTHS Football Boosters for home games. Mike Bradfield made a motion to keep the visitors side concessions and it passed by unanimous show of hands. The coaches have offered to move the shed to the north side of the visitor's bleachers for concession sales. The shed will have electricity and a limited menu for all home games. Mike also stated there will be no food after the game for football players. Saturday game concession proceeds will remain that of the OTHS Football Boosters and will be located in

the garage. Tickets will be sold at all Saturday home games this year with proceeds going to the Football Boosters as well.

Logo Status: Keith Burton stated he will order 200 pins. The design should be ready on July 11th, 2008.

Blue/Gold Game: Mike stated that if the OTHS Football stadium is not completed on time, McKendree University has agreed to use of their field for the Blue/Gold game. All ticket and concession proceeds will go to the OTHS Football Boosters.

Fundraising: The Football Boosters will be having a car wash fundraiser on July 26th and August 10th at the O'Fallon Taco Bell. Tevis Taylor will coordinate the car wash on July 26th and Derrick & Jacqueline Fox will coordinate the August 10th car wash. Two coaches will be in attendance for both dates and there will be a sign up sheet for the players. The Boosters will provide water and a tent for shade.

Picnic: Gail Benton stated the Football picnic will be held in the OTHS cafeteria. The meal will be the same as the Thursday night meals provided to the players. A sign up sheet will be passed around for dessert donations as well as volunteers to set up, serve and clean up.

New Business:

Ice machine: Mike Bradfield will check on an ice machine / refrigerator for the concession stand.

Alumni: Keith Burton will check on letters of support for the alumni.

The mandatory fall sports parent meeting will be held on Monday, August 11th, 2008.

Next meeting will be held on August 14th at 7:00 p.m. in the OTHS cafeteria.

We adjourned to the football stadium at 8:30 p.m. where Mike Bradfield explained the layout and uses of the new stadium.
